PROPOSED CHANGES TO THE CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS

FEBRUARY 25, 2024

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS this congregation is a sovereign fellowship under the Lord Jesus Christ that has entered into voluntary fellowship with the Northwest Ministry Network of the Assemblies of God, and

WHEREAS the Lead Pastor must obtain and maintain credentials in good standing with the Assemblies of God, and

WHEREAS we recognize that Jesus said "the flesh profits nothing" so we do not rely upon worldly weapons (2nd Corinthians 10:4) to guard and protect us from the Enemy, but rather upon the Spirit of God, and

NOW THEREFORE, with a heartfelt love for God and to honor those whom He has called into His ministry (Hebrews 13:17) we, the Trustees in accord with one another and with the pastoral leadership, propose the following changes to the Constitution and Bylaws of LIFECHURCH7 to make them consistent with the above principles and to walk in love to enable growth spiritually and numerically so that none would be lost in the seven cities of our community.

CONSTITUTION OF *Life* CHURCH 7

#1 – Proposed Constitution Change Article II Section 5 Part C– Spiritual Qualification of Trustees

As the Constitution now reads

a. Term and Selection.

- Five trustees shall be chosen from the membership of the assembly. Elections shall be by secret ballot at the annual vision meeting. A simple majority vote shall constitute an election. The term of office shall be for three years. No member of the trustees shall serve more than two complete terms without a recess of one election period. No trustee shall be related by blood or marriage to any other trustee.



Proposed Change as underlined

a. Term and Selection.

- Seven trustees shall be chosen from the membership of the assembly. Nominations and interviews shall be conducted by the Senior Leader, ratified by the Trustees and presented to the membership for a vote. Elections shall be by secret ballot at the annual vision meeting. A simple majority vote shall constitute an election. The term of office shall be for three years. No member of the trustees shall serve more than two complete terms without a recess of one election period. No trustee shall be related by blood or marriage to any other trustee.



#2 – Proposed Bylaw Change Article III Section 5 Part A– Term and Selection of Trustees

As the Constitution now reads

c. Spiritual Qualification of Trustees.

- One who is “alive in Christ,” living in the present fullness of the Holy Spirit, committed to the character standards for leadership revealed in the Bible, and dedicated to ministering to Christ’s church (Galatians 2:20; 2 Peter 1:5-8; 1 Corinthians 16:13-16).
- A member of this church for at least a year.
- Sustains a personal and public prayer life before God, being “instant in season and out of season” (2 Timothy 4:2) and ready for ministry and prayer warfare as the occasion requires (James 5:24). Willing to partner with the pastor by praying for him and be a support to him. Agrees to assist the lead pastor by sharing in the oversight of the church.
- Meets the scriptural criteria of a trustee (1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9).

Proposed Change as underlined

c. Spiritual Qualification of Trustees.

- One who is “alive in Christ,” living in the present fullness of the Holy Spirit, committed to the character standards for leadership revealed in the Bible, and dedicated to ministering to Christ’s church (Galatians 2:20; 2 Peter 1:5-8; 1 Corinthians 16:13-16).
- A member of this church for at least one year.
- Sustains a personal and public prayer life before God, being “instant in season and out of season” (2 Timothy 4:2) and ready for ministry and prayer warfare as the occasion requires (James 5:24). Willing to partner with the pastor by praying for him and be a support to him. Agrees to assist the lead pastor by sharing in the oversight of the church.
- Meets the scripture criteria of a trustee (1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9).
- Leadership in the local church is open to all whom God calls without limitation based on gender. He pours His Spirit out on all flesh, equipping each for ministry in His kingdom (Acts 2:17–18, quoting Joel 2:28–29).

PROPOSED CHANGES

#3 – Proposed Constitution Change Title of Lead Pastor Change

As the Constitution now reads

- The Leader of LIFECHURCH7 is recognized as the Lead Pastor in the current constitution.

Proposed Change as underlined

- Under the Five-Fold Leadership Model as outlined in Ephesians 4 there are five leadership gifts to serve the church: Apostle, Prophet, Evangelist, Shepherd, Teacher.
- With that in mind, the trustees propose the change of the leader of LIFECHURCH7 to be recognized as Senior Leader instead of Lead Pastor.
- In our Constitution and Bylaws the Lead Pastor Title will be changed to Senior Leader where applicable.
